0	SOCIAL SECURITY/RRB INCOME SSA-1099 and RRB-1099
0	PENSION/IRA/ANNUITY Form 1099-R
0	INVESTMENT OR INTEREST INCOME 1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-B, and Schedule K-1
0	TRUST AND ESTATE BENEFICIARY EARNINGS Form 1041, Schedule K-1
0	HOME OR PROPERTY SALE Form 1099-S
0	UNEMPLOYMENT INCOME OR STATE OR LOCAL REFUNDS Form 1099-G
0	HSA AND LONG-TERM CARE REIMBURSEMENTS Forms 5498-SA (contribution tax document) and 1099-SA (distribution tax document)



COMMON DEDUCTIONS

The standard deduction is \$12,400 for singles and \$28,800 for joint filers. So, you may not need to itemize anymore. But if you do, here are the most common deductions.

YES NO	CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS Detailed list of donations, receipts for contributions over \$250, and Form 1098-C for vehicle donations (or a letter confirming donation)
YES NO	CHILD AND DEPENDENT CARE EXPENSES Name, address, and tax ID or Social Security number of the provider
YES NO	EDUCATION EXPENSES Tuition statements, itemized receipts of qualified educational expenses (Form 1098-T), and student loan interest statements (Form 1098-E)
YES NO	HEALTH CARE EXPENSES Records of expenses
YES NO	HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNT CONTRIBUTIONS Form 5498-SA
YES NO	HOMEOWNER EXPENSES Mortgage interest statements (Form 1098), property tax payment receipts, and energy-efficiency upgrade receipts (Form 5695 if provided by installer)
YES NO	IRA CONTRIBUTIONS Form 5498
YES NO	JOB-RELATED EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES Records of expenses
YES NO	SELF-EMPLOYMENT EXPENSES Records of business/home office expenses, assets, pension plan contribution, health insurance payments, and estimated tax payment receipts (state and federal)
